TYPE OF GIFT

One-off Gift

One-off donations under the Gift Aid scheme are the tax efficient way of giving for those who wish to make a gift or a series of single gifts without forward commitment. High rate tax relief also applies.

Gift of Shares

Donating a gift of shares typically represents one of the most tax-efficient forms of giving. Donors are now able to claim 40% tax relief on the total value of the shares, in addition to capital gains tax. Clearly the higher the capital gains exposure of the donor, the more affordable will be the very highest level of gifts.

Company Gifts

Companies can make a donation and claim tax relief when calculating profits for corporation tax. A company would be entitled to offset the full amount of a donation against any of its tax liabilities.

Legacy

Legacies may be left to the National Leather Collection (Museum of Leathercraft). Bequests to charity are deducted from the donor's estate for inheritance tax purposes.
